TERMS & CONDITIONS OF AUTHORIZATION:

1. The Applicant shall comply with the provisions of Bio-Medical Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 1998 notified vide No. SO. 630(E) dated 20th July. 1998.
2. Bio-Medical Waste shall be treated and disposed off in-accordance with Schedule and in compliance with the standards prescribed in Schedule - I.
3. Every Occupier, where required, shall setup in accordance with the time schedule VI, requisite Bio-Medical Waste treatment facilities like incinerator, autoclave, microwave system for the treatment of waste, or ensure requisite treatment of waste at a common waste treatment facility or any other waste treatment facility.
4. Bio-Medical Waste shall not be mixed with any other wastes.
3. Bio-Medical Waste shall be segregated in to containers/bags at the point of generation in accordance with schedule II prior to its storage, transportation, treatment and disposal. The containers shall be labeled according to Schedule III.
6. If a container is transported from the premises where Bio-Medical Waste is generated to any waste treatment facility outside the premises, the container shall apart from the label prescribed in Schedule III, also carry information prescribed in Schedule IV.
7. Now with standing anything contains in the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 or rules there under, untreated Bio-Medical Waste shall be transported only in such vehicle as may be authorized for the purpose by the competent authority as specified by the Government.

13. Chlorinated plastics shall not be incinerated. Toxic metals in incineration ash shall be limited within the regulatory quantities as defined under the Hazardous wastes (Management and Handling) Rules, 1998.
14. Only low sulphur fuel like L.D.O./L.S.H.S./Diesel shall be used as fuel in the incinerator.
15. A pit or trench should be dug about two meters deep. It should be half filled with waste, then covered with lime within 50 cm. of the surface before filling the rest of the pit with soil.
16. It must be ensured that animals do not have any access to burial sites. Covers of galvanized iron/wire meshes may be used.
17. On each occasion when wastes are added to the pit, a layer of 10cm of soil shall be added to cover the wastes.
18. Burials must be performed under close & dedicated supervision.
19. The deep burial site should be relatively impermeable & no shallow well close to the site.
20. The pits should be distant from habitations, & sited so as to ensure that no contamination occurs of any surface water or ground water. The area should not be prone to flooding or erosions.
21. The location of deep burial site will be authorized by the prescribed authority.
22. The Institution shall maintain a record of all pits for deep burial.
23. Occupier will install incinerator/APCM of its own or having common facility within 2 months and will submit scheme along with time-phased programme within 15 days.
24. Occupier will submit analysis report after the installation of incinerator/APCM.
25. Occupier will comply all the directions for generation, collection, reception, storage, transportation, treatment, disposal & handling as per Bio-Medical Waste Rules (Management & Handling) Rules, 1998 and will ensure that there is no adverse effect to human & Environment.
26. The Occupier will segregate the Bio-Medical Waste at the point of generation in accordance with the Schedule-II of Bio-Medical Waste Rules (Management & Handling) Rules, 1998. The every occupier will also submit the copy of agreement every year before 30 April from any authorized service provider.
27. The authorization would be subject to having proper disposal system for Bio Medical Waste.
28. The unit shall maintain a log book for segregation/ collection of Bio Medical Waste at the source (i.e. wards) and also each category of waste incineration, autoclaving or land fill etc.
29. The Yellow Bags should be non-chlorine bags.
30. The unit will also provide needle destroyer in each ward.
31. The unit will submit the compliance report of above said conditions within 15 days positively.
32. The healthcare unit will maintain the record for proper collection, storage of the spilled mercury from the damaged thermometers, pressure, instruments & equipments and sending of the same to the manufacturer.
33. The healthcare unit will submit the annual report in Form-II by 31st January every year.

6. If a container is transported from the premises where Bio-Medical Waste is generated to any waste treatment facility outside the premises where Bio-Medical Waste is generated to any waste treatment facility outside the premises, the container shall apart from the label prescribed in schedule III, also carry information according to Schedule IV.
7. Notwithstanding anything contains in Motors Vehicle Act, 1995 or rules there under, untreated the Bio-medical Waste shall be transported only in such vehicle as may be authorised for the purpose by the competent authority as specified by the Govt.
8. No untreated Bio-Medical Waste Shall be kept stored beyond a period of 48 hours.
9. Every authorised person shall maintain records related to the generation, collection, reception, storage, transportation, treatment disposal of Bio-Medical Waste in accordance with those rules & any guideline issued.
10. All records shall be subject to inspection & verifications by the prescribed authority at any time.
11. Suitably designed pollution control devices should be installed/retrofitted with the incinerator to acheive the above emission limits, if necessary.
12. Waste to be incinarated shall not be chemically treated with any chlorinated disinfectants.
13. Chlorinated plastics shall not be incinarated.Toxic metals in incinaration ash shall be limited with the regulatory quantities as defined under the Hazardous Waste Management Rules, 2016.
14. Only low sulphur fuel like L.D.O/L.S.H.S/Deisel shall be used as fuel in the incinarator.
15. Occupier will comply all direction for generation, collection, reception, storage, transportation, treatment, disposal as per Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules 2016 & will ensure that there is no adverse effect to human & Environment.
16. The occupier will segregate the Bio-Medical Waste at the point of generation in accordance with the special-II of Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.
